BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:

Little information is known about Charles Leslie Gilliland. He was born about 1877 and was originally from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Charles made annual trips to Arizona starting around 1901. On one of his first trips to Oracle, Arizona he met Helen Galey. The two were married in 1908. Helen's father, William Thomas Galey was the founder of the textile company Aberfoyle Manufacturing Company in Chester, Pennsylvania. Charles worked for his father-in-law as treasurer of Aberfoyle Manufacturing Company, and later founded the Cotton Products Company in Philadelphia. The couple had a son, Charles Jr. about 1911.

In 1923 Charles purchased Phoenix Date and Citrus Properties, which later became Gilliland Groves. The couple built a large residence in Oracle, called El Rancho Robles (the oak ranch). The Gillilands also built St. Helen's Church in Oracle, in 1927. They provided the building costs, all the furnishings and vestments; a generous donation of over \$5,000. By 1936, Charles resigned from the Cotton Products Company in Philadelphia and made his permanent home in Arizona. He is believed to have died in Phoenix around 1941.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

This collection contains over 1250 original images. All photographs were organized in albums, the original order is unknown. When, why, and by whom the albums were disassembled is also unknown. Some of the photographs are noted on the back as to their original album and page number, most are not captioned. When the albums were disassembled some photographs were glued back-to-back or were unable to be removed from their original black paper backing. The photographs range in condition from fair to

very good. All photographs are individually encapsulated and sleeved. This collection documents the Gilliland family, their homes, farms, and daily ranch life in southern Arizona. The collection is organized by subject then chronologically within.
