WILLIAM GILLELAN TO JAMES HANNA JUNR

DATED: 9/17/1782; CULBERTSON'S CREEK FOR 96 LBS. GOLD, ACREAGE NOT SPECIFIED.

Know all men by these presents that I William Gillelan of the County of Greenbrier & State of Virginia have for divers goods causes & considerations me thereunto moveing bargained sold alien'd and confirmed and by these presents do bargain sell alien and confirm unto James Hanna Jun of the County and State aforesaid all my right title and interest in and to a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being on the head of Culbertson's Creek and County aforesaid – which I bought of John W. Caslan and the right thereunto unto the sd James Hannah's heirs and assigns I do hereby warrant & defend in as full xample a manner as I received the same from the aforesaid John W. Caslin provided that if the said William Gillelan his heirs & assigns shall well & truly pay unto the said ~~William Gillelan his heirs & assigns shall well and truly pay unto the said~~ John W. Casline his heirs & assigns the sum of ninty six pounds current money of Virginia in gold or silver for the payment of which the said James Hanna at the request of & for the benefit of me the said William Gillelan hath become security and further shall keep the said James Hanna his heirs executors & administrators indemnified of & from any costs charge or incumbrance of and by reason of being security for payment said money then this obligation to be void or else remain in full force power & virtue. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 17th day of September 1782.
