This Indenture made this twenty forth day of February 1816 between William McClintick and Agness his wife of the one part and John Handly & Nathan Gilliland of the other part both of the County of Greenbrier and State of Virginia witnesseth to that for and in consideration fifteen hundred dollars part of a sum of money of two thousand two hundred thirty dollars & eighty nine cents which said John Handly & Nathan Gilliland went said McClintick Security for to Lincon Quinn the receipt whereof the do acknowledge hath bargained and sold by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said Handly & Gilliland a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Greenbrier whereon said McClintick now lives joining Joseph McClintick and John Handly & bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a line all white oak & Hickory & running thence north fifteen deg E 160 poles to a hickory West 58 poles to a small white oak on a ridge N 60 W 40 poles to a white oak on the side of a ridge corner to Gilliland & with his line N 30 W 40 poles to a white oak & hickory & having said line S 64 W 106 poles to a yellow Lynn by a branch S 30 E 4 poles to a double hickory corner to Boggs & with S 5 E 90 poles to a chestnut & Chesnut oak and hill and S 55 W 40 poles to a black oak on side line & leaving S 30 W 92 poles to two white oaks on a point S 66 W 40 poles to a red oak & also by a Spring S 19 E68 poles to a white oak & hickory N68 E 18 poles to a black oak corner to Lockridge E 86 poles to a white oak on the top of a ridge N 26 E 23 poles to a walnut & elm N 80 E 110 poles to a black oak N 23 E 75 poles to the beginning. The above tract containing three hundred & sixty acres which McWilliam, McClintic & Agness McClintic for ? one heirs do covenant with John Handly & Nathan Gilliland their heirs the above tract or parcel of land with all the appurtenances to the sole use & behoof of the said Handly Gilliland & their heirs forever.
