

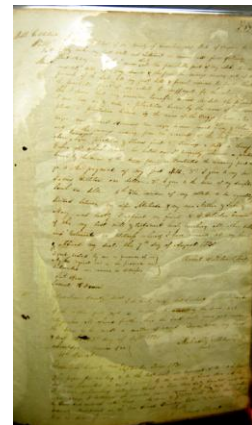

I, Robert Gillilan, of the county of Greenbrier State of Virginia do hereby make my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say ---- 1<sup>st</sup> I desire that all the perishable part of my estate to be immediately sold after my demise & therefore the moneys owing out of the proceeds of the sale bill my just debts of funeral expenses be paid should the perishable part of my estate should be insufficient for the above purpose then I desire that my executor hereafter named to sell the plantation I now live on and a plantation known by the name of the can (?) place a plantation known by the name of the Boggs place also a negro man name Harrison two negro women named Lucy & Ethen and out of the moneys arising from the proceeds of the sale of the above named home plantation & slaves first to discharge a debt to Henry Erskin & to which claim he holds on sd property likewise a plantation known by the name drinin place in Pocahontas the remaining part to go to the payment of my just debts. 2<sup>nd</sup> I give to my son James Gillilan one dollar. 3<sup>rd</sup> I give to the heirs of my daughter Sarah one dollar. 4<sup>th</sup> the residue of my estate to be equally divided between my wife Malinda & my sons Nathan & John and Mary and lastly I appoint my friend G. R. Gillilan Executor of this my last will & testament hereby revoking all other wills & testaments in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 7<sup>th</sup> day of August 1830.
